Veteran distance runner, Ezra Colbourne won the Annual 10K Love Run in a time of 40:16, on Sunday afternoon, February 9, hosted by the Sea View Farm Community.

Colbourne was closely rivalled by Neville Nichols in 40:17. Gehr Coates (Wings) finished with a third place time of 40:35.

In the Female category (overall) Cassie Vitalis (Wings) finished ahead of her pack in 47:48. Kevinia Francis ran 50:46 to finish second, while Abbie Davis 56:28 and Lindsay Duffy 56:42 made the finish line at third and fourth places, respectively.
